

## **Legislative Decree 81/2008, Article 26 Obligations related to service or work contracts – Waste management –**

All operators providing any type of service within Arcoprofil S.r.l. are required to comply with the following rules, aimed at ensuring proper environmental management in accordance with current environmental regulations and the UNI EN ISO 14001 standard.

The disposal or recovery of any waste generated during the performance of the service is responsibility of the contractor, who, according to the law, is considered the waste producer.

The contractor must provide appropriate collection containers that are suitable for the hazardous characteristics of the waste, to ensure safe handling and storage of waste within the areas where the activity is carried out, considering that:

1. Different categories of hazardous waste must not be mixed together.
2. Hazardous waste must not be mixed with non-hazardous waste.
3. Waste containers must be properly identified and labeled.

Waste generated during the service must be collected and handled to prevent any spillage within the company spaces or externally on the transit areas.

All operations carried out within company sites must be managed to ensure environmental safety:

- Discharge of wastewater generated by activities into the internal sewage system is strictly prohibited.
- Waste abandoning within company sites is strictly prohibited.
- Exhaust gas emissions from vehicles must be limited (e.g., by avoiding unnecessary engine idling).
- Proper handling of chemical products used during the activity at company sites is required.

In the event of an emergency (e.g., accidental spillage of hazardous waste, fire), the contractor must promptly contact the supervisor of the relevant department and the undersigned Head of the Prevention and Protection Service.
